







Independent Party Primary Results

The Independent Party of Oregon is the state's third largest political party with more than 100,000 members, according to information on the Oregon Independent Party website.

On July 7 - 19, the Independent Party held its primary election for 2014. The Party sent out a survey and a ballot to its members.

This year's results favored Republicans, which is contrary to just two years ago when the results favored Democrats.

There were eight contested races where the Republican candidate beat the Democratic candidate, including the race for Governor. In the gubernatorial race, Republican Dennis Richardson beat Democrat John Kitzhaber with a 677-413 vote.
