Bob has been active in western Washington County for years, having served as the President of the Hillsboro Chamber of Commerce, a board member on the Tuality Health Foundation, and as President of the Oregon Association of Nurserymen. In addition, Bob is a board member (and founder) of the Oregon International Air Show, held each summer at the Hillsboro Airport. Since its founding, the Air Show has made over \$1.1 million in donations to the local community.

Bob is also on the Washington County Budget Committee, which helps the Washington County Board of Commissioners formulate annual budgets for the various services provided by Washington County.

It has been a long time since Washington County has had a candidate as qualified as Bob Terry. Like Andy Duyck, Bob is a fiscal conservative who will protect Washington

County residents from wasteful spending, while working to attract businesses to western Washington County.
